Graduate studies in music at Minnesota State University lead to the Master of Music degree. The Master of Music degree is a professional degree, most appropriate for recent graduates and professionals who desire to increase their knowledge and hone their skills as a performer, conductor, or teacher. With remote learning options, there are possibilities for currently-employed public school teachers to pursue an MM in Music Education. Core classes will be offered FlexSync, lessons and private instruction can be taught remotely via Zoom, and the majority of the College of Education courses are offered remotely. Students can also add certificates in Educational Technology or Racially Conscious School and Systems Leadership by choosing electives that fulfill these certificate requirements.
